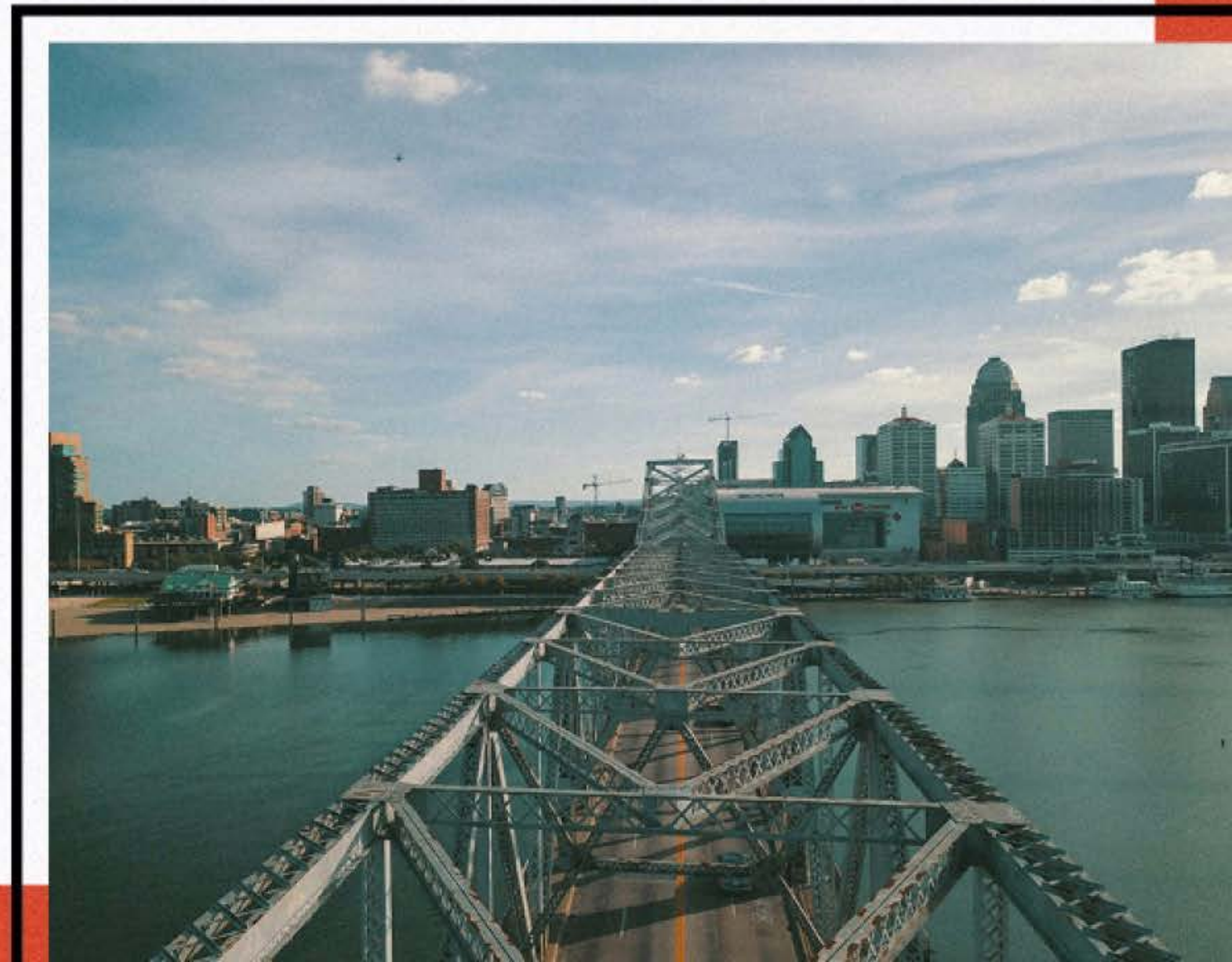
- Pray

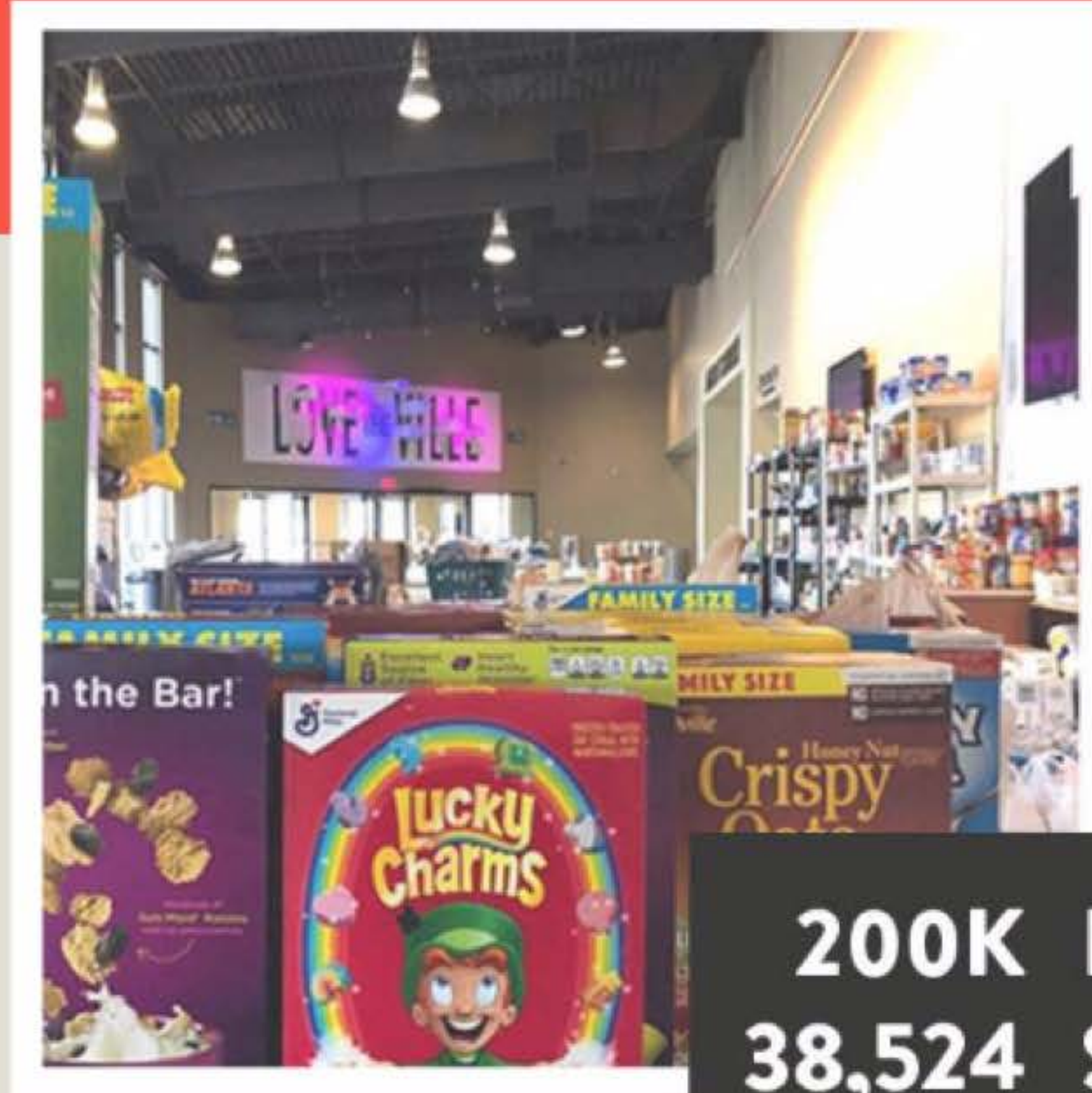

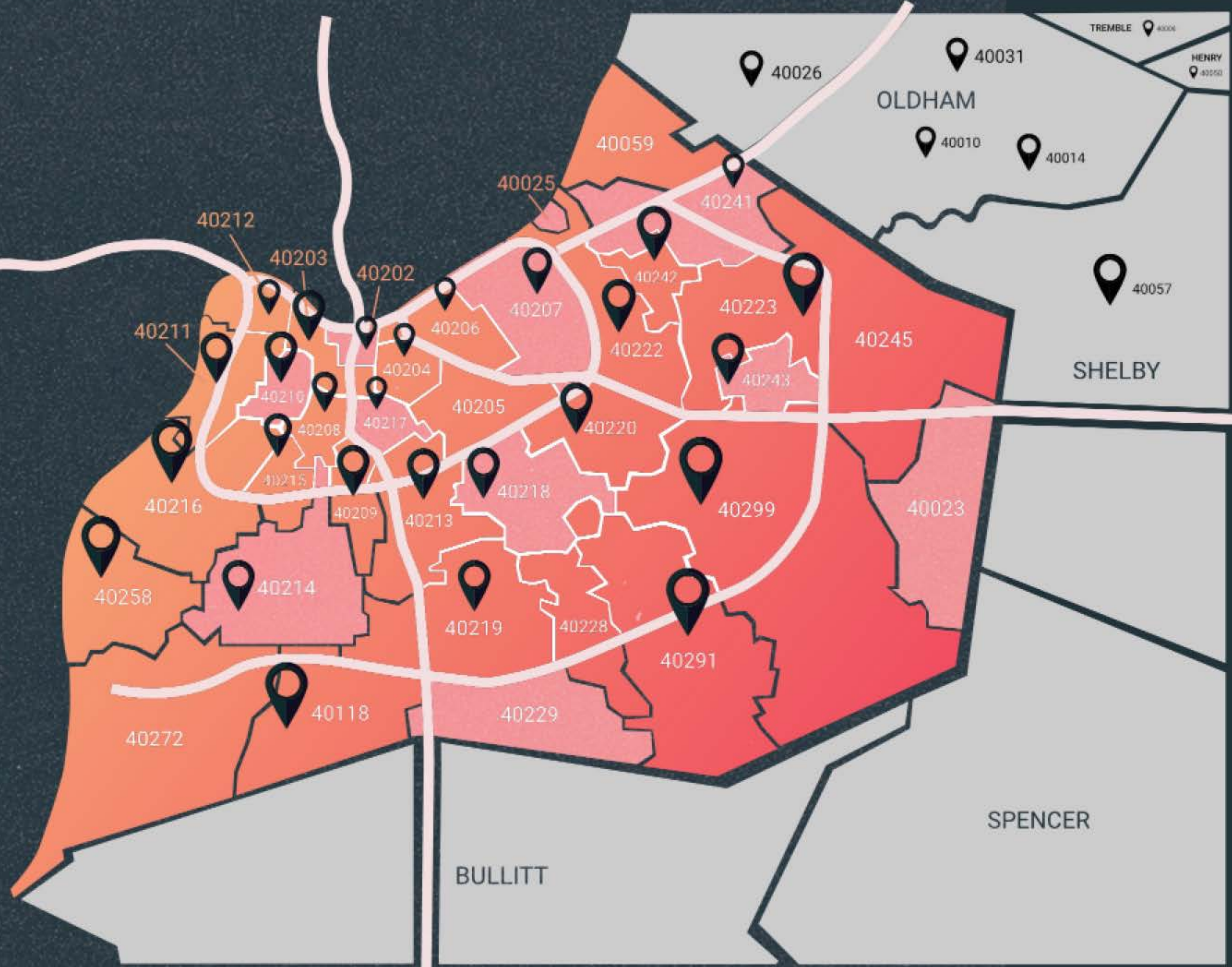
