# **BIG IDEA**

Ecclesiastes begs the young to love and obey God now rather than pretending like it is something for later in life when you "grow up." The wisdom of God is like compound interest this side of heaven. The sooner you become an investor, the greater the dividends are over time.

### **GROUP OPENER**

Share a piece of wisdom someone imparted when you were young and has paid dividends. Or share a wisdom you wish you had embraced sooner and why.

### **GROUP DISCUSSION**

- Read this longer passage Ecclesiastes 12:1-14. Twice out loud, in different versions of the Bible everyone listens.
- What are some significant observations you have about this text? What stood out? What didn't you like? What was confusing?
- What does this passage teach us about God? How does it change how I see God?
- What does this passage teach us about humanity/ourselves? How would it change how I treat others?
- What does this passage teach us about obedience? How should it affect the way I live?

## As a Group

#### Discussion:

What about the young that can make them resistant to the wisdom of others?

What has been helpful for you in accepting outside wisdom?

Read: Romans 12:1-2
